HOPKINS Royals 54, LAKEVILLE NORTH Panthers 51

Hopkins edged Lakeville North 54-51 in the Lakeville North Summer League championship game held at Lakeville South. Two weeks ago LN won by 20. However both teams were missing some of their heavy cannons tonight, but all that did was give opportunities for some players to answer the knock at the door. Tori Joransen broke a 51 all tie with 1:26 left on a post up and two Hopkins possessions later Meghan Westman made one free throw for the final margin. LN was held scoreless their last four possessions.

This game had a little bit of everything. At the start the teams were looking for the key to unlock the basket. Perhaps they both teams were looking to adjust to the different player combinations. Together both teams were only 1/10 to start the game. Once they found the key to offense their was no stopping the point avalanche. In one sequence both teams scored on 8 straight possessions. Hopkins pushed their lead to 17-12. LN went on a 9-2 run to take a 21-19 lead after a 3 by Rachel Berkvam. Rachel Banham had two straight &1 opportunities in that stretch converting on one. Hopkins finished the half with an 8-3 run. Jill Greenfield had six of those points thanks to two three point plays — one old fashioned, and one behind the arc.

LN had a surge at the start of the half with 15 points in their first 8 possessions. Hannah Hughes delivered two 3s in the run and had all 12 of her points in the second half. Hopkins' Shackelford quickly tied the game with three straight lay ups thanks to two quick steals off the press. Hughes got the Panthers back in front with an &1. Joransen tied it with the next three Royal points. There were five lead changes and two ties that followed, the last coming at 51 all. Joransen scored what proved to be the game winner on an &1 chance. She missed the free throw and LN got the d board. For the next four possessions LN came up empty.

Missing in action today: for LN: 6-4 Cassie Rochel was out recovering from an illness. Also missing was Taylor Stewart, Jaya Perkins, Mckenzie Hoelmenn who are all at club team tournaments. For Hopkins: Hana Potter, the Coffey sisters Sydney and Nia, Gracia Hutson are all off with their club teams. Brianna Williams is out with a knee injury.

The reason this game was held at LS was due to the water damage to the floor at LN (\$30,000 worth).
