

# Spy Out & About: Hopkins/Armstrong

Out and about: Classic Lake Conference Championship: **Hopkins Royals 60,**  
**Armstrong Falcons 47**



Sophomore guard Brianna Williams survived early foul trouble and broke open a tight contest, exploiting a size-and-strength mismatch at the top of the Falcons' zone to help Hopkins clinch the conference title. The score was close through the first 28 minutes. Williams picked up two quick fouls and was tagged with her third at the 3:00 mark in the first half. Armstrong showed nice hustle and poise, looking for scoring opportunities on fast breaks and ball movement to open up three-point shots, including two in a row by Ali Hoefer. Hopkins countered with the inside strength of Kara Elofson and Hana Potter. Armstrong led at the half 28-24.

Williams returned to the lineup and got hot in a hurry. When she wasn't elevating over the top of the Falcons' relatively small zone up top, she was driving to the hoop for an old-fashioned three-point play. The Falcons' shots stopped dropping, and a late-game scoring flurry by Williams (again) and Elofson put the game out of reach. Williams led Hopkins with 25; Elofson and Potter combined for 21, and Jenna Lillemoe added 10. Armstrong was led by Hoefer with 15, with balanced scoring from three other starters, Nicole Dooher (9), Elizabeth Wilson (10), and Kristi Loobeek (8).
